## Firearm, Ammunition Seized, 2 Stolen Vehicles Recovered

Police seized a firearm along with a quantity of ammunition and recovered two stolen vehicles during Operation Blue Line exercises over the past 48 hours.

On Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> November, officers of the North Central Division Task Force, Area West conducted an exercise in areas surrounding Caura Village. While searching a bushy area on Tumbasound Road, they discovered one firearm, along with ten rounds of ammunition. The items were secured and lodged at the Tunapuna Police Station.

Also, during another exercise conducted between 7 pm and 11 pm yesterday, the officers spotted a white Hyundai Elantra, believed to be involved in a robbery incident in the Central area. The vehicle was placed under surveillance, however, the assailants escaped and the vehicle was later found abandoned in the district. The vehicle was then taken to Arouca Police Station to be processed by the Northern Division Crime Scene Unit.

Meanwhile, earlier this morning, officers of the North Eastern Division Task Force received a report of a white Kia K2700, which stolen from the Arouca district. Based on information received, they proceeded to Bushe Street, Petit Bourg, where a search was conducted and the vehicle was recovered, and then conveyed to San Juan Police Station for further processing.

Enquiries are continuing into the finds.
