Cannabis Seized, Man Arrested During Anti-Crime Exercises

A 34-year-old Enterprise man has been arrested and a significant quantity of cannabis seized during a targeted intelligence-led operation in the Central Division yesterday.

Acting on intelligence, a team of officers went to Area West of the Uriah Butler Highway, specifically near the Caroni Bird Sanctuary. During a search of the area, a black plastic bag was discovered under a parked forty-foot container trailer. Officers of the Special Operations Unit retrieved the bag and found ten brown plastic packets, each filled with cannabis. The narcotics were seized, weighed, and amounted to a total of 5.4 kilograms with a street value of approximately \$100,000.00 TTD.

Cpl. Carter is continuing investigations into this seizure.

Additionally, officers also acting on intelligence went to a location in Central Division, within the Chaguanas Police Station district, between 5:30 PM and 8:30 PM on the same day. The officers conducted a search at a home in Enterprise Street, Chaguanas.

During the search, they discovered four plastic packets containing cannabis, which weighed approximately 1800 grams with an estimated street value of \$35,000.00 TTD. As a result, a 34-year-old man was arrested and taken into custody at the Chaguanas Police Station pending further investigations by PC Ramnath of the Special Operations Unit.
