Several Suspects Held, Gun and Cannabis Seized in Exercises

Several suspects were arrested and a firearm and quantities of ammunition and narcotics seized by officers during anti-crime exercises, which were conducted overnight in several Divisions.

In the Toco district, officers conducted a Warrant Exercise between 4 pm and 10 pm, on Saturday 1st, March, 2025, during which five persons were held on outstanding Affiliation, FI and TAC Warrants.

In the Western Division, Task Force officers conducted an exercise between 10 am and 4 pm, yesterday, during which they proceeded to the Glencoe home of a male suspect.

There, they conducted a search, which resulted in the discovery of 1.6 kilogrammes of cannabis hidden in a closet in the house.

The suspect, who was on the premises at the time of the search, was arrested in connection with the find.

The same party of officers then proceeded to the Petit Valley district between 12 am and 3 am, today, Sunday 2nd March, 2025, where they conducted a search at Second Street, Morne Coco Road.

There, they found a white crocus bag containing a micro-conversion kit along with 10 rounds of 5.56mm ammunition.

Meanwhile, officers of the Tunapuna Criminal Investigations Department and North Central Crime Scene conducted a drug eradication exercise between 1 am and 4 am, yesterday.

During the exercise, the officers, acting on intelligence, proceeded to the Caura home of a female suspect.

There, they found a large quantity of cannabis and three pieces of camouflage clothing.

The 30-year-old woman was arrested in connection with the finds.

In the North-Central Division, members of the ACP Operational Task Force, conducted an exercise between 12 noon and 5 pm, yesterday, during which they proceeded to Spring Lands Avenue, Valsayn, where they conducted a search which resulted in the discovery of 3.7 kilogrammes of cannabis.

And, in the Eastern Division, Task Force officers conducted an exercise between 6 pm and 9 pm, yesterday, during which they arrested a 26-year-old Sangre Grande man in connection with gang-related offences.

The officers also discovered one revolver loaded with three rounds of ammunition at Zion Trace, Sangre Grande.

Investigations are ongoing into all of the above matters.
