## Man Denied Bail for Sexually Penetrating Cousin, 17

A 29-year-old man was denied bail yesterday when he appeared virtually before a Port-of-Spain Magistrate charged with one count of sexual penetration of a 17-year-old girl.

The accused was remanded into custody and will reappear before the court on November 5<sup>th</sup>, where the validity of the alternative address provided would be deliberated.

The suspect was arrested and charged on November 2<sup>nd</sup> by WPC Eccles of the Western Division, Child Protection Unit (CPU), following a police report on November 1<sup>st</sup>, in which a 17-year-old girl told CPU detectives that she was allegedly made to have sexual intercourse with a man whom she knows.

Earlier that day, officers attached to the Community Policing Oriented Section (COPS), Western Division, were doing routine patrols and follow-ups at a school, where they discovered that a mentee was absent.

The COPS officers conducted further enquiries into the whereabouts of the child who was later found to be at a guest house in West Trinidad.

The incident was then transferred to the CPU who later arrested and charged the suspect with one count of sexual penetration of a child.

The investigation was spearheaded by W/Superintendent of Police, Claire Guy-Alleyne, with direct field supervision by W/Sgt Simmons and Cpl (Ag.) Davis of the Western CPU.
