Tobago Police Arrest Two, Seize Cocaine, Cannabis, Ecstasy, Meth Near Primary School

A businessman and a known offender were arrested, and officers seized several dangerous drugs, items of interest, and cash during an operation in the Tobago Division yesterday afternoon.

Between 2:00 pm and 5:00 pm on 6th March 2025, an intelligence-led operation was conducted in the Crown Point District. After weeks of surveillance, a team of officers from the Tobago Divisional Task Force, Area West, and the Canine Unit searched the home and business place of a 30-year-old man on Kilgwyn Bay Road, Bon Accord—mere metres away from a primary school—under the State of Emergency Regulation of 2024.

During the search, officers found several dangerous narcotics, including 2,972 grammes of cannabis, 256 grammes of cocaine, 28 Ecstasy pills, and 5 grammes of a substance believed to be crystal meth. They also seized a can of pepper spray, several scales, a vacuum sealer and packaging materials, along with TT\$377,273.00 and US\$355 in cash.

The items were seized, and two men—the business owner and a 41-year-old man known to police—were arrested. The latter was also found with 14 grammes of cocaine on his person.

This operation was strategically directed by ACP Subero, coordinated by Snr Supt Elie, spearheaded by ASP Area West/Operations Leetang, and supervised by W/Ag Sgt Harris and Cpl Guy.

Investigations are ongoing.
