One Suspect Held, One Stolen Vehicle Recovered in Operation

One suspect was arrested and one vehicle which was reported stolen, successfully recovered by officers of the Stolen Vehicles Squad, during an operation conducted in the Northern and Central Divisions, yesterday.

The strategic operation spearheaded by Snr. Supt. Winston Maharaj, W/Supt. Claire Guy-Alleyne and ASP Narine, was conducted during the period 10:15 am and 6 pm, on Monday 20th January, 2025.

During the exercise, officers proceeded to an auto service business in the Arima district, where they met with the owner and conducted checks of several motor vehicles parked on the compound.

One silver coloured Nissan AD Wagon with no registration plate was traced and found to have been reported stolen in the Arouca district in 2023.

The male business owner was arrested in connection with the matter.

Meanwhile, the same party of officers then proceeded to the Freeport district, where they met with a man who is the registered owner of a silver coloured Nissan Tiida motor vehicle.

The officers informed the man that they had information that a motor vehicle he allegedly owned had been in a serious road traffic accident in 2016 and subsequently destroyed by fire. They alleged that the vehicle he currently owns may have been either stolen or unlawfully obtained.

Checks revealed the Tiida's chassis alphanumeric had been tampered with.

The vehicle was seized pending further investigations.
