## Five Arrested, Revolver and Cannabis Seized in Exercises

Five suspects were arrested and a firearm and quantities of cannabis and cash seized by officers who conducted State of Emergency Operations yesterday.

In the Central Division, Criminal Investigation Department (CID) personnel conducted an exercise between 4 pm and 8 pm, on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2025, during which they proceeded to the Enterprise district, where they conducted a search in the vicinity of an abandoned structure.

There, the officers found one Smith and Wesson revolver loaded with two rounds of ammunition.

In the North Central Division, Task Force officers, along with personnel of the Gang and Intelligence Unit, conducted an exercise between 4 pm and 9 pm, yesterday, in the St. Joseph district.

Acting on information, the officers proceeded to Pasea Village, where they conducted a search at the home of a 41-year-old suspect.

The search resulted in the discovery of two packages containing 1.1 kilogrammes of cannabis.

The suspect who was on the premises at the time of the search, was arrested in connection with the find.

Meanwhile, officers of the Shirvan Road CID and Gang and Intelligence Unit conducted an exercise in the Tobago Division, between 11:20 pm on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2025 and 3:30 am on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> February, 2025.

During the exercise, officers proceeded to the home of a 40-year-old suspect, where they conducted a search, which resulted in the discovery of a quantity of cannabis and the seizure of quantities of US and TT currencies.

The suspect and a woman, who were on the premises at the time of the exercise, were arrested in connection with the finds.

And, in the Bon Accord district, officers arrested a 29-year-old man after he was found in possession of quantities of US and TT currencies. The cash was seized under the Proceeds of Crime Act, pending investigations.

Meanwhile, in the Northern Division, Task Force officers conducted an exercise in the Arima district yesterday, during which they proceeded to St. Joseph Street.

There, they searched a house and found several packets of cannabis with an estimated street value of TT\$37,089.

A 66-year-old man who was in the house at the time of the search, was arrested in connection with the find.

Investigations are ongoing into all of the above matters.
