Three Arrested, Cannabis, Cocaine, Firearms, and Ammunition Seized - CD Division

An intelligence-led operation carried out in Central Division led to the arrest of three men and the seizure of cannabis, cocaine, firearms, and ammunition on January 29th, 2025.

Between the hours of 10:00 AM and 7:30 PM, officers stopped a multi-coloured Mazda vehicle along the Southern Main Road in Cunupia. Upon searching the vehicle, officers discovered a firearm along with 21 brass cylindrical ammunition. The driver, a woman from Southern Main Road, Cunupia, was arrested in connection with the find and taken into custody.

The operation then moved to Dyette Street Extension, where a white Nissan wagon was observed with two men inside. A check revealed that the vehicle was bearing a false registration number. The men, from Dyette Street Extension, Cunupia, and Evelyn Street, Ojoe Road, Sangre Grande, were arrested and are currently under investigation.

The operation continued with a search of a residence on Church Street, Cunupia, where officers seized 240 grams of cannabis and 27 grams of cocaine. The man residing at the property was arrested, and the drugs were seized.

The operation was coordinated by Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP) Investigations and Intelligence, Suzette Martin, along with officers from the Central Division Gang Unit, Northern Division Gang Unit, Special Investigation Unit, and the Central Division North Task Force.
