Accused Car Thief Gets \$250,000 Bail

NAZRUDEEN SOOKOOR, a 27-year-old labourer of Friendship Village, San Fernando, appeared virtually before Magistrate Indira Misir-Gosine of the Princes Town Magistrates' Court today, after he was charged with four counts of larceny motor vehicle.

The accused pleaded not guilty to the charges and was granted bail in the sum of \$250,000 to be approved by the Registrar of the Court.

On Tuesday 19th December, 2020, a Toyota Aqua motor vehicle which was reported stolen, was recovered intact on the same date, in a bushy area off the M2 Ring Road, Picton Village, bearing a false registration plate. The vehicle was processed by Crime Scene Investigator, PC Harricharan who found workable prints which were later identified to be that of someone known to them.

Personnel of the Princes Town CID conducted extensive enquiries spearheaded by Sgt Teeluck, and they arrested SOOKOOR, on Friday 22nd January, 2021 and interviewed him. He was subsequently charged with larceny motor vehicle.

SOOKOOR was also questioned and charged in connection with the larceny two other Toyota Aqua motor vehicles and a Toyota Axio motor vehicle.

The matter was adjourned to Monday 22nd February 2021.
