#### **NDTF Officers Discover Suitcase of Cannabis, Three Arrested**

Four persons have been arrested, a firearm and a quantity of narcotics seized, and a stolen vehicle recovered following operations conducted by officers of the Northern Division on Saturday, March 29, 2025.

Between 6:00 pm and 11:30 pm, officers of the Northern Division Task Force, Area South, conducted an intelligence-led roving operation across the Arima District. During the operation, officers stopped a white Nissan Note carrying a driver and two passengers. A search of the vehicle revealed a suitcase containing 11 bar-like wrapped packages with 3.862kg of cannabis. The three men, aged 24, 30, and 38, all from Fyzabad, were arrested in connection with the find.

Additionally, based on intelligence, officers proceeded to the South Western Division where they searched an open lot of land in the Fyzabad district. There, they discovered a pump-action shotgun hidden in a black plastic bag under some bushes.

In an earlier operation, officers arrested one man in connection with a black Nissan B15 motor vehicle, which had been stolen earlier that day from Woodford Street in Arima. The vehicle was later recovered in Calvary Hill, Arima.

These operations were coordinated by Snr Supt Maynard-Wilson, Supt Guy-Alleyne, and ASP Pitt, and spearheaded by Insp Haywood.
